### **Brief Biography**

Since 2001, Congresswoman Susan A. Davis has proudly represented California's 53<sup>rd</sup> Congressional District in the United States House of Representatives. Stretching from I-5 and Balboa Park on the west, through Mission Valley to East County, and continuing south to Chula Vista, California's 53<sup>rd</sup> Congressional District includes much of the heart of San Diego.

In Congress, Susan is a senior member of the House Committee on Education and the Workforce, serving as Ranking Member of the Subcommittee on Higher Education and Workforce Development. She also a senior member of the House Armed Services Committee. Susan's signature issues include defense, education, health care, veterans' affairs and election reform.

Prior to Congress, Susan served 6 years in the California State Assembly and 9 years on the San Diego Unified School District Board of Education. After growing up in northern California and graduating from the University of California at Berkeley, Susan earned a master's degree in Social Work from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.
